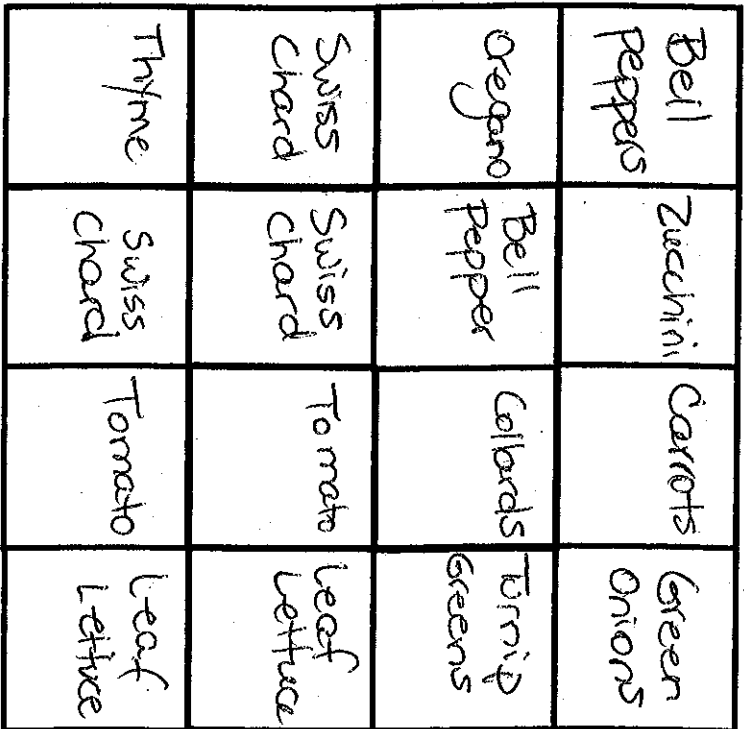


GARDEN PLANNING CHART - SAMPLE

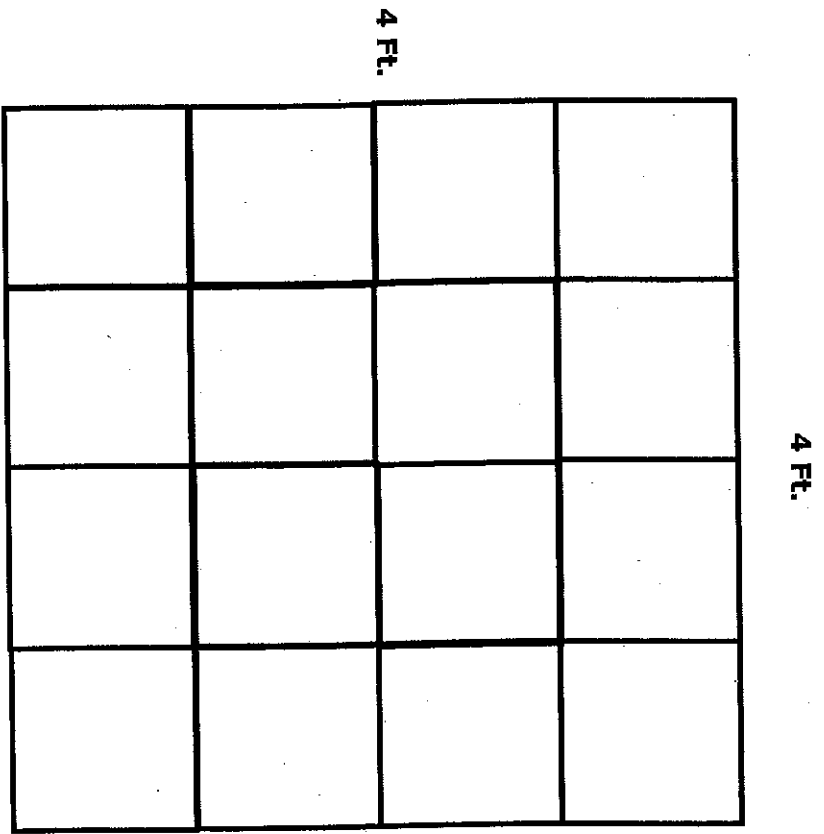


1. Choose the vegetables you want to grow in each square.
