Position Overview: Volunteer will assist in the distribution of fresh produce to clients at one of the food bank's Mobile Food Pantry sites throughout the DC Metropolitan Area.

Primary Duties:

- Reporting to site coordinator for job instruction
- Distributing numbers to clients to reserve their place in line
- Unpacking produce (could include repackaging into manageable amounts for clients)
- Collecting client information regarding the number of people in each household
- Distributing produce to clients in the amount specified by the site coordinator
- Cleaning up packaging and pallets

Minimum Requirements:

- Must be able to travel to the Mobile Food Pantry site (many are Metro accessible)

Physical Requirements:

- Must be able to lift 30 pounds
- Must be able to work outdoors for up to three hours

Volunteer Work Schedule:

- Three-hour shifts occurring:
 - Monday and Friday, 9am-1pm
 - Tuesday-Thursday, 9am- 6pm
 - Saturday 7am-12pm

Position Location:

- One of 40+ locations in DC, Maryland and Virginia. The position location will correspond with the volunteer's interests and travel capacity.

Impact of this volunteer opportunity:

- Engage in direct service food distribution
- Become familiar with a local service agency or housing facility
