WHAT WE DO: DC Diaper Bank is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that works to provide a reliable and adequate supply of free diapers to families in need living in the Washington, DC metropolitan area. We provide diapers to social service organizations that are already connected to and helping low-income families through comprehensive programs and services.

GET INVOLVED: Capital Area Food Bank partner agencies make up the DC Diaper Bank's distribution network.
