How to participate	Why it matters
GIVE FOOD 5 LBS = 1 POINT	14% of DC residents struggle to get the food they need 1 in 6
GIVE MONEY \$1 = 1 POINT	Children are food insecure in our region \$300
GIVE TIME 1 VOLUNTEER = 100 POINTS	Reported increase in grocery bill for low-income families in summer months when children are out of school



Each year, the Capital Area Food Bank feeds 540,000 people in the Washington metro area through a network of 444 food assistance partners. The food bank distributes 42 million pounds of food annually, of which one-third is fresh fruits and vegetables.



In 2016, 44 firms and allied organizations raised \$275,000 through Food From the Bar DC.
